

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY PROTECTION POLICY

Respect for copyright is one of the core principles of operation of the Public Organization “The Stanislav Dnistrianskyi Centre for Law and Politics” (hereinafter referred to as the Organization). With this in view the Organization shall use only the objects of copyright, the property rights for which have been duly obtained, shall show zero tolerance to plagiarism as a way of creation of copyright objects and shall take steps to protect intangible rights of persons who are the authors of the materials placed on the website.

Copyright to all information (textual, visual, multimedia, etc.) available on the website shall belong only to its authors and the Organization.

Citing of the information available on the website shall be allowed without the Organization’s consent only as citation in the scope determined by the legislation and justified by the goal set, and exclusively with reference to the Organization, the author of the publication, and the website as the source of its obtaining.

The use of materials available on the website shall be allowed for educational, creative, and journalistic objectives, provided such use does not aim at getting profit, with preservation of the integrity of the materials and reference to the Organization, the author of the publication, and the website as the source of their obtaining.

If it is necessary to use of the information available on the website in the scope exceeding citation and for the purposes other than educational, creative, or journalistic, please address the authorized representatives of the Organization following the information available in the section “Contacts”.

It shall not be allowed to perform any unlicensed copying or use such information in any other way that is not allowed by the present Policy.

In case of unapproved use of information from the website, the Organization shall reserve the right to take steps to protect own intellectual property rights, the rights of the authors and experts and third persons against their violation and use not in good faith, including via addressing law-enforcement and judicial authorities.
